 Daughdahl of the County of Cherokee in said State of  
 the 2nd part Witnesses that the parties of the 1st part  
 for and in consideration of the sum of four thou  
 sand dollars to them in hand paid by the



party of the second part the receipt of which is  
sincerely acknowledged have given granted bargained  
and sold and by these presents do give grant bar-  
gain and sell to said Daughdall an undivided  
(North) interest in the following land lying in said  
County and known as follows to wit all of Section  
gifted except the N 1/4 of the NW 1/4 thereof also the S 1/4  
of the S 1/4 of Section 10 also the S 1/4 of the S 1/4 & N 1/4
