

The State of Alabama This Indenture made and
 Shelly County & entered into this 31st day of
 October 1862 between Melis R Papp & Caroline
 Papp husband & wife of the first part & Hooper
 Mass of the second part all of said County &
 State Mississippi That for & in Consideration of
 the sum of twenty five hundred dollars
 by the party of the second part to the parties of
 the first part in hand paid the receipt of
 which is hereby acknowledged the said parties
 of the first part have this day bargained &
 sold and by these presents do bargain
 sell & convey to the said party of the second
 part the Tract lot in which the said parties of
 the first part have for some years past res-
 sided & resided as follows to wit beginning at the
 NE Corner of said lot on the south side of
 said Stout Street & on the west side of North
 Stout & running south with the west side of North
 Stout a distance of about two hundred & twenty
 four yards to the SE Corner of the old Holman
 lot (which is a part of the lot here described) thence
 west along the south line of said old Holman
 lot a distance of one hundred and thirty eight
 yards to the SE Corner of said old Holman
 lot thence north along the line (in a little detour)
 between said old Holman lot and Dr & M.
 Jones lot & in continuation of said line in
 a straight line to the south edge of said Stout
 Street a distance of about two hundred & twenty
 four yards and thence east along the south
 edge of said Stout Street a distance of about
 one hundred and forty eight yards to the place
 of beginning supposed to contain nearly six and
 three fourths of an acre more or less to have
 & to hold the aforementioned lot of land with the
 improvements & appurtenances thereto belonging
 to the said party of the second part his
 heirs and assigns forever and on the
 said parties of the first part Covenant &
 agree to & with the said party of the second
 part that we are lawfully seized of the
