T² S. Range one East also the N^W 1/4 of the N^W 1/4 of
section 28 Township 21 Range one East among other
properties to secure amongst other things debts a
debt to Do R. D. Hubbard for a debt amounting
to something over two thousand dollars and the
said Richard R. D. Hubbard having a deed of trust
and said land Alder than the said conveying said
land to said Amos M. Elliott which gave to said Hub-
bard a junior lien and the said Hubbard having
sold said land to said Mrs. Piper in full satis-
faction for the debt due from said Wm. Buzby.
Whence now therefore I Amos M. Elliott as stated
in consideration of the promises of said Mar-
thy and quit claim to said Martha J. Piper
all the title interest in said lands which vested
in him by said deed given said Wm. Buzby
