 Shelly County 3 entered into the 23rd day
 of November A.D. 1863 between Samuel Brasher
 and Margaret S. Brasher his wife of Shelly County
 Alabama of the first part and George S. Harris
 of the second part. Witnesseth that the said par-
 ties of the first part for and in consideration
 of the sum of Eight thousand Dollars to them
 in hand paid by the said party of the second

grant the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 have this day bargained and sold and by these
 presents do grant bargain sell and convey unto the
 said George S. Marr the following described land
 lying in said County of Shelby viz. the South East quarter
 of Section 32 Township 21 Range one East the
 North East quarter of Section 5 Township 22 Range one
 East and the East 1/2 of the North West quarter of Section
 5 Township 22 Range one East and the West half
 of the North West quarter of Section 5 and the East
 half of the North East quarter of Section 6 Township
 22 Range one East containing together five hundred
 and forty seven 15/100 acres and the West half of the
 South East quarter of Section 30 Township 21 Range one
 East containing 76 16/100 acres and the South West quarter
 of Section 30 and the East half of the South East
 quarter of Section 31 all in Township 21 Range one East
 To have and to hold the said lands together with all
 the rights and appurtenances thereto belonging to the
 said George S. Marr his heirs and assigns forever and
 we do Covenant with the said George S. Marr that we
 are lawfully seized in fee of the above granted premises
 that they are free from all incumbrances that we
 have a good right to sell and convey the same and that
 we will warrant and defend the premises to the said
 George S. Marr his heirs and assigns forever against
 the lawful claims and demands of all persons
