 County and John Thayer and Cobb Thayer of the second
 part of the State of North Carolina Witnesseth that for the
 said John F Woodward and L. A Woodward for and
 in consideration of the sum of Ten hundred dollars
 to us in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged have bargained sold and delivered
 and by these presents do grant bargain sell and deliver
 unto the said John Thayer and Cobb Thayer a Certain
 tract or parcel of land lying the S W 1/4 of the S W 1/4 Sec
 1 T 19 Range 2 East also the N W 1/4 of Sec 12 T 19 Range 2
 East also the S W 1/4 of the S E 1/4 and S E 1/4 of the S W 1/4 Sec 36
 T 18 Range 2 East containing Two hundred and eighty acres
 more or less in the District of Tuscaloosa and State of
 Ala all except one half acre are which the Grave yard
 now standing To have the said John Thayer and Cobb Thayer
 for their heirs &c to have and to hold the above bar-
 gained or conveyed Premises with all the appurtenances
 thereto pertaining or in any wise appertaining and
 the same forever to our heirs executors administrators
 assigns forever and forever from the Claims of the
 Confederate States and from all manner of persons
 or persons claiming the same in law or
 Equity In Witness Whereof we have hereunto set our
 hands and Seals this day and year above written
