 County to wit all of Section 14 Which lies West of Ralls
 Creek the E¹/₄ of E¹/₄ of Section 15 the E¹/₄ of the E¹/₄ and
 the W¹/₄ of E¹/₄ of Section 13 and the W¹/₄ of Section
 24 all in Township 18 Range 2 East Containing in all eight
 hundred and ninety acres more or less to have and
 to hold to the said McKie his heirs and assigns for
 ever and we the said first Trusty do hereby Cove-
 nant and agree with said 2nd Trusty that we are
 lawfully seized in fee of the land aforesaid that we
 have a good right to convey and sell the same
 in manner and form aforesaid and that we will
 forever warrant and defend titles in fee simple
