

Be it known that the following agreement at this day entered into between John S. Storro & William Mills both of Shelby County Alabama to wit The said Storro is to guarantee the said Mills with Twenty dollars in Gold with which to enter lands in Section 34 T. 21 R. 4 West and the said Mills binds himself to convey in fee simple to the said J. S. Storro his heirs and assigns all the trees timber & forest now standing growing or which may hereafter grow upon the following described land in consideration of the above said sum of money to be paid by said Storro to wit the E 1/4 the E 1/4 of S E 1/4 the W 1/4 of S E 1/4 also the E 1/4 of the S W 1/4 in Sec 34 Township 21 Range 4 West also the N E 1/4 of the N E 1/4

of Sec. 3 Town ship 22 Range 4 West Pseudora Land
 West of And said Mills agrees to convey in fee simple
 to said Storo his heirs and assigns all the coal in
 or upon said described land also the right to enter
 upon said land at any point thereof to cut down
 such trees & timber use the same as said Storo
 his heirs & assigns may deem fit also for mining
 for coal sinking shafts driving Gungways edging
 coal with the right to build road or roads of any
 kind he may wish at any place at such times
 & manner as said Storo his heirs & assigns
 may wish The said Mills retaining the right to
 farm said land & cut such timber as may be
 necessary for farming purposes full given
 under our hands & seals the first day of June in
