 -band and wife of the first part and J. M. Perry
 of the second part Witnesseth that the said party of
 the first part for and in consideration of the sum
 of five hundred forty five dollars to them in hand
 paid by the said party of the second part the re-
 -ceipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have sold
 and hereby sell conveyance and convey unto the said
 party of the second part the following described
 Land lying in Shelly County State of Ala to wit the
 NW¹/₄ of the NW¹/₄ of ^{Section 19} Township 18 Range 1 East
 & the NW¹/₄ of the NE¹/₄ Sec 4 Township 18 Range 1 East &
 also the E¹/₄ of the E¹/₄ of Sec 13 T¹/₈ Range 1 East also
 the SE¹/₄ of the NE¹/₄ S¹/₈ T¹/₈ Range 1 East also. The NE¹/₄ of
 the NE¹/₄ Sec 4 T¹/₈ Range 1 East all in the Sec 10
 -sa land District and State of Ala containing
 five hundred thirty seven acres more or less to have
 to hold to the said party of the second part
 their heirs & assigns forever the above described

land & premises and the said parties of the first
part husband & wife hereby covenant with the said
party of the second part that we are lawfully seized
of land here good right to sell and convey said
land & hereby bind ourselves and heirs legal heirs
-children & assigns to warrant defend the title to said
land and premises to the said party of the second
part their heirs legal representatives against the
claims of all every person either in law or equity
and against the Government of the Confederate States
