

This indenture made and entered into this the twenty first day of September AD 1843 between the Trustees of the Central Rail Road of the first part & I & my wife Mary Ann Corp of the said Shelby Co Ala of the second part Witnesseth That for and consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged & for the further consideration of their Railway Company building their Rail Road and along the Land now occupied by the Trustees of the second part in Shelby County Ala known as the NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec 24 & the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sec 23 Township 20 Range 3 West adjoining lands of R C Corp's Headman & others the Trustees of the second part hereby grant bargain sell & convey unto the Trustees of the first part the Right of Way through the entire tract of land in width fifty feet on each side the Center line of the R Road with all & singular the Rights privileges & appurtenances to said Strip or parcel land any and every pretence to have or to hold the same to the party of the first part their assigns in fee simple forever Connected with the Right of Way the Rail Road Company shall have the Right to cut down and remove all said trees undergrowth or bushes as would be, shade or falling on the Road injure the same and to remove the same the Trustees of the second part have hereunto set their hands and seals this day & date above written
