 between N. L. and his wife Nancy of the first part and
 Thomas B. Miller of the second part all of the County &
 State aforesaid. Witness that the said party of the first
 part hath this day conveyed and sold and do by these
 presents Grant bargain and sell unto the party of the
 second part a certain tract or parcel of land lying
 and being in the County of Shelby State of Alabama
 and in the Tascaloosa Land District to wit all that
 portion of the West half of the North East quarter (which
 lies West of the prairie branch containing about
 Sept acres (60 acres) and all of that portion of the East
 half of the North West quarter (which lies South East
 of the ridge upon which N. L. & his said wife
 Runway North and South. Supposed to be twenty or

Twenty acres more or less all in Section twenty two Township
 twenty Range three West for the Consideration of the sum
 of six hundred dollars to the party of the first part in
 hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 and the said party of the first doth for themselves their
 heirs executors administrators and assigns will
 warrant and defend all the right title and interest of
 said land unto the party of the second part his heirs &c
 together with all that thereunto belongs In testimony whereof
 we have hereunto set our names and affixed our
