be again sold and by these presents do give grant
 bargain and sell to said Shulley Iron Co eighty feet
 wide the right of way for their rail road through
 my land which land lies on the North side of the
 road running from Columbus to the depot on the
 St Louis River Rail Road crossing the center of said
 rail road the center line of said right of way and
 it is hereby understood and recorded to me that
 said Shulley Iron Co are to make the necessary stock
 gaps in said right of way and I am to be pay-
 -able to cultivate the land crossed by said right
 of way up to the ditches and embankments pro-
 -vided I do not rise and in no case interfere
 with the transportation over said road to have
 and to hold the said Shulley Iron Co and their
 successors and assigns forever (Witness my hand
