 9 and E^{1/2} of N^W 1/4 Section 2 and E^{1/2} of N^W 1/4 Section
 9 Township 20 Range 1 West to have and to hold to
 said second party his heirs and assigns forever.
 The above described and hereby granted land and
 premises and the said parties of the first part hus-
 band and wife hereby Covenant with the said party
 of the second part that we are lawfully seized of
 and have good right to sell and convey said land
 and hereby and ourselves our heirs and legal
 representatives forever to warrant and defend the
 title to said land and premises to the party of
 the second part his heirs assigns and legal
 representatives against the Claims of all and every
 person in law or equity and against the Govern-
 ment of the United States under our hands and seals this
 day and year above written
