Shelby County 3 into this 15th day of November A.D. 1864
between Julius Strong and Caroline Strong husband and
wife of the first part and John Churchhill of the second
part, witnesses That the said parties of the first part
for and in consideration of the sum of Two thousand
five hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the
said party of the second part the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged have sold and hereby sell Con-
veyed and convey unto the said party of the second
part the following described land lying in the Town
of Columbus Shelby County State of Alabama to wit
the lot containing two acres lying on the North side of
the Rail Road N.E. of the depot improved by Joseph
Roper and more particularly described as follows
beginning at a corner between Mrs. Smith's lot and
a branch on the North side of the Rail Road thence West
with the Rail Road boundary 14 poles & 5 links thence
North with the fence to the West boundary line of the
Egg of S. Egg of sec 23 T 21 R 1 West a little less than
6 chains thence N and said line 5 chains thence East
4 chains 24 links to Mrs. Smith's lot thence S & with
Smith's line 10 chains to the beginning containing two
acres more or less to have and to hold to said second
party his heirs and assigns and legal representatives
against the claim of all and every person in law
or Equity and against the Government of the United
States of America under our hands and seals
