 Stalley County & entered into this 20th day of
 April 1865 between John Churchhill of the first
 part and Georgia A Churchhill Mother of said
 John Churchhill of the second part both of said
 County of Stalley and State of said Alabama That
 the said party of the first part for and in con-
 sideration of the Natural love and affection
 which he bears for the said party of the second
 part as well as the sum of ten dollars to him
 in hand paid by the ~~second~~ party of the second
 part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 have given granted conveyed and sold and
 hereby give grant convey and sell confirm
 and convey unto the said party of the second
 part the following described land lying and
 being in the Town of Columbus and in said
 County and State of said Alabama to wit the lot contain-
 -ing two acres lying on the North Side of the
 Alabama River Rail Road North East of & first
 improved by Joseph Popper and more particularly
 described as follows: Beginning at a Corner
 between the Smiths lot near a branch on the
 North Side of the Rail Road thence West with
 the Rail Road boundary 14 poles & 3 links thence
 North with the line to the West boundary line of
 the South East Quarter of the South West Quarter
 of Section 23 Township 20 Range 8 next a little
 less than six chains thence North on said line
 5 chains thence East 4 chains & 24 links to the
 Smiths lot thence South East with the South line
 10 chains to the beginning containing two acres
 more or less to have and to hold to the said

and separate use of said party of the 1st part her
widely heirs and assigns forever from the
Control of the husband of the said party of the 1st
part (she being a married woman) the above
described and hereby given and granted premises
and the said party of the first part hereby
covenants with the party of the second part that he
lawfully seized of and have good right to sell
and convey said land and hereby covenants him-
self his heirs and legal representatives forever
to warrant and defend the title to said land
and premises to the said party of the second
part his heirs & legal representatives against
the claim of all and every person in law or equity
and against the Government of the United States
