Hargrett of the second part of the same County and State of said Alabama that for and in consideration of the sum and one hundred and seventy five dollars to us in hand paid by the said party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged we have sold the following described land by the North East quarter of the North East quarter of Section 33 Township 34 Range 13 East containing forty acres more or less to have and to hold the said land with all the appurtenances and privileges thereunto belonging to the only proper use and benefit of the said party of the second part we the said party of the first part hereby certify to and into the said Hargrett to warrant and defend the title to the land hereby conveyed in testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals this day and next to wit the 6th day of December 1859.
