 Township 24 Range 15 & to have to hold to said Edwards  
 his heirs and assigns forever and never the  
 said 1st party will forever warrant and defend  
 title to said land to said Edwards his heirs  
 for me and of which me and his heirs and  
 wife the day signed above written
