 Township No 20 of range and East containing eighty acres
 more or less to have and to hold the above described
 tract or parcel of land together with the Lummings and
 appurtenances thereto belonging as in any case
 appertaining unto the said John Archer his heirs
 and assigns forever and against us and all and
 every person or persons claiming or holding under
 us the said first parties and also against the lawful
 title claim or demand of all and every person or
 persons whatsoever claiming or holding by force
 or under the government of the Confederate States

 set our hands and seals the day and date above

 said Samuel Bonisher the said Samuel Bonisher
 sold to the said James R and Mary J Allen a lot
 containing of four acres in the North West Quarter of the

 26 in Township 21 of Range 111 East and the said Sam-
 -uel R and Mary Ellen went into possession of said lot
 upon which there was then no improvement and then
 -selved built the dwelling house kitchen and other out-
 -buildings thereon and enclosed the same for the said

 by the said James R and Mary Ellen in the improve-
 -ments aforesaid as well as for the natural love
 affection which he has for the said parties of the
 third part as his infant Grandchildren has been
 -purchased and sold and they have promised to grant
 conveyance sell and convey to the said parties of the second
 part the lot and premises herein before described
 to hold in trust for the said parties of the third part
 and for their use benefit and behoof and the said
 parties of the first part will forever warrant and
 defend the title to said parties of the second part as
