

Whereas Isaac Gorman of Shelby County State of Alabama
 is justly indebted to J. R. McDaniel & Sissie Bgoam of Lippin-
 -son County and State of Georgia in the sum of one thousand
 ninety three dollars and seventy five cents by his personal
 -usage. bearing even date with these presents payable to
 said McDaniel Bgoam & Ingers as their order as follo-
 -wing to wit by monthly from date bearing eight per
 -cent interest and amounts the said Isaac Gorman is desirous
 of securing the payment of said ^{the} debt with the understand-
 -ing that he is at liberty to pay the whole or any part of said
 debt upon the same shall be so considered and payable
 Now therefore the said Isaac Gorman in consideration
 -tion of the premises and of the sum of one dollar
 to him paid by Gains Lee of Shelby County in the
 State of Georgia the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-
 -edged have granted bargained and sold and
 by these presents do grant bargain sell & convey

unto the said Gains Lee and his assigns forever the
lands following to wit the West half South West fourth
of S 15 T 18 R 11 W also a part S W 1/4 of the N W 1/4 of S 15 T 18 R 11 W
beginning the South East Corner of said quarter &
thence the N line to the main road thence South
of West with said road to the section line also across
more or less of said road beginning at a pine bush
near the road and running at N W Course about 78
yards unto the small red oak marked thus X thence
with the main road N E directed to a chestnut stake
marked a hollow thence to a red oak near the road
marked thus X thence to the beginning also the S E of the
S W 1/4 of same Section 11 W and a part of the N E 1/4 of said
quarter section described as follows beginning at the N W Corner
of said quarter and running the N line to the main road the N W Corner
of the said 1/4 to a Corp fence thence S E along said fence to the
South line thence W to the beginning also the E 1/2 of S W 1/4 & the N
E 1/4 of S W 1/4 of S 22 T 18 R 11 W containing in all 15 acres more or less
to have its hold the same to the said Gains Lee and his assigns
for ever in trust however that the said Gains Lee of the said
sum of money as any part thereof shall remain unpaid and
paid at the expiration of six months from the date hereof shall
make sale of the premises herein conveyed at Public vendue
to the highest bidder for Cash at the front door of the Court
House in said County between the hours of 10 of the morning & 5 in
the evening having first given 4 weeks public notice of time place
& terms of said sale of said property by various advertisement
in some public news paper printed in or nearest to said
County and upon such sale shall make execute and deliver to
the purchaser thereof a good and sufficient deed of Con-
veyance of all the right title interest hereby conveyed to the
said Gains Lee and out of the proceeds of said sale shall
pay first the Cost and Charges of this trust second the debt
herein remaining due and payable to the said McDaniel
Boggs & Jones or their assigns and third should any
balance remain shall pay the same to the said Isaac
Gorony or his legal representatives but if the said Isaac
Gorony shall within said six months with and truly pay or
Cause to be paid the said debt interest and Cost & charges
of this trust then the said Gains Lee shall convey the
premises aforesaid to the said Isaac Gorony or his assigns
in Witness Whereof I the said Isaac Gorony have hereunto
set my hand and seal this the 30th day of December 1866
