This Indenture

made this 20th day of April A.D. 1866 between
Thomas Glaspock of the first part George W. Booth & S. M. Wells
& J. D. Woods Second part
Witnesseth That the said party of the first part for a valuable
consideration does hereby grant and lease unto the said parties
of the second part their Executors, Administrators and Assigns
the sole and exclusive right to all the Oil, Coal Copper Gold or
Silver Iron or other Minerals in upon and under a certain
tract or parcel of land described as follows, to wit

N.E. 1/4 & N.W. 1/4 Section No 3 Township No 23 Range No 14
S.E. 1/4 & S.W. 1/4 Section No 4 Township No 23 Range No 14
20 Acres S.W. 1/4 Township No 23 Range No 14 Section No 3
containing one Hundred and Eighty acres more or less lying or
being in the State and County aforesaid to have, and to hold said
right for the term or period of Twenty one years from the date
of this Indenture together with the right during said term
to enter upon said land and occupy so much of the surface
thereof as will be necessary to carry on the operations of boring
or mining for said Oil Coal or other Minerals collecting, storing
and preparing the same for market. Boulding and paying
therefor unto the said party of the first part to him or his
Heirs or Assigns the tenth part of all the Oil Coal and other
Minerals obtained upon the said premises each party to furnish barrels
for his her or their own share of the Oil. The parties of the second
part shall also have the right to remove their engines machinery
and tools whenever they may choose to suspend operations upon
said premises. And it is further agreed that the parties of the
second part shall have the right of way through said premises
to and from their places of work
