 first part for a valuable consideration does hereby Grant and
 lease unto the said parties of the second part their Executors
 administrators and assigns the sole and exclusive right
 to all the Petroleum Oil Copper Gold or Silver or other
 valuable mineral or volatile substances all that certain
 tract of land situated in Shelby County and State of
 Alabama and bounded and described as follows, to wit
 S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ and the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of section No. 14 in Township
 No. 23 of Range 14 East containing one hundred & thirty
 eight 2500 Acres containing acres more or less lying &

being in the state and County aforesaid to have and to hold said rights for the term or period of twenty one years from the date of this Indenture together with the right during said term to enter upon said land and occupy so much of the surface thereof as will be necessary for said oil coal or capped Gold or silver or other minerals collecting storing and preparing the same for market yielding and paying therefor unto the said party of the first part him or his heirs or assigns the tenth part of all the oil capped Gold or silver and other mineral obtained upon said premises each party to furnish barrels for his or her or their own share of the oil the parties of the second part shall also have the right to remove their engines machinery and tools whenever they may choose to suspend operations upon said premises and it is further agreed that the parties of the second part shall have the right of way through said premises to and from their places of work in witness whereof the parties hereunto set their hands and seal day and date aforesaid
