

The State of Alaska and This Indenture made and entered into
 Sheslay County this 5th day of November AD 1864 between
 Washington R. Rushing and Sarah Rushing husband and wife
 of said County and State parties of the first part and Horace
 Moor of said County and State of the second part (Witnesseth that
 the said parties of the first part for and in consideration
 of the sum of Three hundred Dollars to them in hand paid
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have they day
 bargained and sold and do hereby these presents grant and
 give sell and convey unto the said party of the second
 part and to his heirs and assigns forever the following des-
 cribed lands viz the East half of the South West quarter of
 Section four (4) and the North East quarter of the North West
 quarter of Section 9 all in Township 24 Range 15 East and the
 North half of the North East quarter of Section 17 and the
 South East quarter of Section 8 in Township 24 Range 15 East
 lying in said County of Sheslay also all the wood and timber
 of every description on the following lands viz the North West
 quarter of the North West quarter of Section four and the
 North East quarter of the North East quarter of Section five
 Township 24 Range 15 East in said County and the said
 parties of the first part hereby conveys to said party of the
 second part the right to enter upon said last named
 lands and to cut and remove said timber off said lands
 and all right of way necessary for the entry upon cutting
 off and removal of said wood and timber as bearing
 the same to Court on said lands at pleasure to have &
 to hold to said party of the second part and to his heirs
 and assigns forever and the said parties of the first
 part covenants with said party of the second part that
 they are seized in fee of said lands and have a good
 right to sell & convey the said lands conveyed and the rights

to said wood and timber on said lands last named
and that they will forever warrant and defend the title
to said lands and the right to wood and timber as here-
in conveyed forever and against the claim of all every
person and the claim of the Government
