hold to him said Charles of the Vanhook and to his heirs and assigns Now the Conditions of the foregoing
deed in trust to this of the said Settlement Gibson shall
pay as cause to be paid said described debt and
the Cost of this deed by the first day of January 1868
then this deed is void and of no effect but if said
party of the first part shall fail to pay said specified
debt by said time specified the Forster any time
hereafter is authorized and empowered to sell said
described tract of land to the highest bidder for cash
in the Town of Monteville first giving notice of such
sale in three public places in the County and forsooth
to sell after notice of thirty days before said sale and sell
for cash appropriate for ends of such sale the payment
of said debt and Costs Should any money remain in
the hands of Forster after paying as aforesaid he do to
pay balance to Settlement Gibson in Monteville whereof
the aforesaid parties have hereunto set their hands
