 notes said notes due Nov 17/66 with interest from
 date And now the said party of the second part being
 desirous of securing the payment of said notes. and
 for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar

 or any part thereof shall remain unpaid the the
 said party of the second part agrees that the
 said party of the first part shall take said land
 in to possession after giving thirty days notice by
 publishing in the public places shall proceed to sell
 to the highest bidder for cash. And after paying
 said notes & interest and all cost of said deed of
 trust shall pay the balance if any over to the said
 second party or his legal representatives. And both parties
 agree that said second party shall have possession
 of the above mentioned land, and premises free of
 rent, until the expiration of said deed of trust.
