 Adm of the Estate of R M Threate deceased, of the first
 part and Thomas Merit of the second part all of
 Shelby County State of Alabama Witnesseth that
 the said second party is justly indebted unto said party
 of the first part in the sum of Eighty nine $5\frac{5}{100}$ Dollars
 due by promissory Note due 17th November 1866, with from
 date and now the said party of the second part
 being desirous of securing the payment of said
 Note and for the further consideration of the
 sum of one dollar to him in hand paid

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has
 this day bargained and sold unto the said party of
 the first part the following land to wit:
 S W $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 26 T 19 R 2 East N W $\frac{1}{4}$ of N W $\frac{1}{4}$ & N E $\frac{1}{4}$
 of N W $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 35 T 19 R 2 East also S E $\frac{1}{4}$ of S E $\frac{1}{4}$
 Sec 27 T 19 Range 2 East, Making in all (280)
 two hundred and eighty acres. Known as the
 Green Wood place to have and to hold in
 trust until 25th day of December 1867 and
 if said debt is not paid the said party
 of the second part agrees that the
 said party of the first part shall enter
 said land into possession and after giving
 thirty days notice ~~for~~ the same public sale
 shall proceed to sell to the highest bidder
 for cash and after paying said debt and
 interest and all cost of said debt in
 trust shall pay the balance over
 to the said second party or his le-
 gal Representatives and both parties agree
 that said second party shall have
 the above named land and premises
 free from trust until the expiration
 of said debt &
