Warner in the sum of one hundred and ninety dollars by account due January 1st 1860 for goods wares and merchandise and a judgment in favor of O. E. Fardy against me and one Johns Oaters

Court for said County which said Claims are
now in the hands of said B B Lewis as attorney
for collection now to secure the payment of said
Claims and indebtedness aforesaid as well as in
consideration of ~~the~~ Dollars to me in hand paid by

acknowledged I have bargained and sold and by these
presents do bargain sell transfer and assign to the
said B B Lewis a certain judgment of the Circuit
Court of said County and State in my favor and against
one Thomas Gillison rendered March 14th / 67 for three
hundred and eight Dollars Damages and seven
76⁰⁰ Dollars cost together with full powers to
renew and receipt for all money that may be
received on said judgment and full control
of any executions that have or may be issued
on said judgment the said judgment being in
titled to a credit of fifty Dollars the said Lewis
after paying himself his fees as aforesaid which
include the Commissions on said judgment
truly transferred he is to apply the residue of said
judgment when collected to the said Claims pro
rata and credit them accordingly with this
