 Shelby County Entered in to, this the 14 day of
 November 1867, Between George V Webb Debtor of the
 first part - and William Earnest and N B Mardis
 Creditor of the second part - Witnesseth, That
 whereas the said party of the first part is justly
 indebted to the said parties of the second part
 in the sum of Two hundred due by promissory note
 bearing even date here with due and payable on
 or before the first day of November 1868. And
 the said party of the first part being desirous
 to secure the payment of said indebted-
 ness for aid in consideration thereof and for
 the further consideration of the sum of one
 Dollar to the said party of the first part in hand
 paid by the said parties of the second part the
 Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said
 party of the first part has sold and hereby sells
 and conveys to the said parties of the 2^d part the following
 described property to wit, Two mules, One Mare Colored
 Mare mule, About nine years old, the other a bay horse
 mule about nine years old, To have and to hold
 in trust as follows. It is hereby agreed that
 the said party of the first part is to have and
 retain possession of said property until
 the 1st day of November 1868 and if

the said party of the first part shall fully pay to the said party of the second part said debt with the interest there on and the Reasonable expenses here of by the said 1st day of November 1868. Then this indenture is to be null and void, But upon default of such payment said party of the 2^d part is hereby authorized to take into possession and sell said property to the highest bidder for cash after giving twenty days notice of the time and place of said sale by advertisement posted up at the public places and out of the proceeds of said sale retain the said sum of Two hundred dollars and interest thereon and the Reasonable cost here of And the balance if any pay to the said party of the first part But if said mules fails to pay when sold said note and interest thereon the parties have no recourse on the party of the first part for the unpaid balance.
