

The State of Alabama This indenture made and
 Shelly County entered into this 6th day of
 November A.D. 1866 between Coleman Heatty
 Sarah Heatty his wife of said County and State
 parties of the first part and John H. Williams
 Administrator of the Estate of Henry P. Williams
 Decd of said County and State party of the
 second part, Witness; that whereas the said
 Coleman Heatty is justly indebted to the said party
 of the second part in the sum of One thousand
 two hundred & four $\frac{4}{100}$ Dollars with interest thereon
 on from the 25 day of December 1861 due
 by a promissory note made by said Coleman
 Heatty on the 21 day of January 1861 and pay-
 able the 25 day of December next thereafter
 to H. P. Williams for said sum of One
 thousand two hundred & four $\frac{4}{100}$ Dollars and
 the said parties of the first part being anx-
 ious and desirous to secure to said party
 of the second part said note and interest
 thereon now due and to be in consideration
 of the premises and for and in consid-
 eration of the sum of five Dollars to
 them in hand paid the receipt where-
 of is acknowledged the said parties
 of the first part have this day bar-
 gained and sold and by these presents
 do grant bargain sell and convey to
 the said party of the second part the
 following described lands to wit; the North
 West quarter of the North West quarter

of Section 16 and the west half of the south west
quarter of Section 9 & the south west quarter
of the north west quarter of section 9
& the south east quarter of the north west quarter
of section 9 all in Township 22 Range East
to have and to hold to said party of the sec-
ond part & to his heirs and assigns forever in
trust however upon the following conditions
that the said party of the second part shall
enter at once into the possession of said land
and if the said party of the first part Col-
man Heatty shall pay off said note and the
interest thereof and the expenses hereof by
the first day of August next then the title
to said lands shall remain in said parties
of the first part as fully as though this con-
veyance had not been made, but should said
parties of the first part fail to pay said note
and the interest thereon or any part thereof by
the first day of August next then and in
that event the said party shall advertise said
lands at public sale for thirty days by posting
up notice at three public places in said County
and proceed to sell said lands at public sale
before the Court House door of said County
and with the proceeds pay of and satisfy said
note interest & the expenses hereof and on
making said sale convey to the purchaser all
the title to said lands either legal or equi-
table which vested in said parties of the first
part including the right of Power of said Sarah
Heatty in testimony whereof the said parties
of the first part have here unto set their
hands and seals the day and year above
written
