for ever a certain tract to have and to hold the
same forever, in trust however that the said William
Morrow if the said sum of money or any part thereof
shall remain due and unpaid at the expiration
of said time shall make sale of the said tract at
public vendue to the highest bidder for cash and
out of the proceeds of said sale shall first pay the cost and
charge of the trust the debt and interest remaining due paya-
ble to the said William Morrow or his assigns and
third if any ~~short~~ balance should remain shall
pay the same to the said Levi Crenshaw or his legal
representatives. But if the said Levi Crenshaw shall
within the said twelve months well and truly pay or cause
to be paid the said debt interest and cost and charge
