 hereby relinquish all right title and claim
 in said cattle unto him the said A. M.
 Stracner, to have and to hold as
 his own right and property on condi-
 tions the conditions under written if
 the said F. M. Bradshaw pays or causes
 to be paid forty six dollars & ninety six
 cents by the 25th day of December next
 then said cattle will be the property
 of said Bradshaw or failing so
 to do said Bradshaw is hereby
~~compelled~~^{bound} to deliver said cattle the
 26 day of December next to him the
 said A. M. Stracner, F. M. Bradshaw
