hires & assigns for ever according to the law & the Statute made and provided in such cases as by said Recital and Full Relation being there unto had appears now know ye that the said Nedham Lee & Nancy Lee his wife for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred & 50/100 Dollars the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by these presents have and each of them Remised Released & for ever quitclaimed and do by these presents Remise Release quit Claim Surrender and give up unto the said Lyman & Davis & to his heirs and assigns all the Estate and Estate Claims demands and rights of them the said Nedham Lee and Nancy Lee his wife in Law or Equity or otherwise hereever and especially the right and Equity of Redemption and power of in to & out of the following described tract of land to wit; the South East quarter and East half of South West quarter Except ten acres ten acres of the North End which is dead off, and that part of the North East quarter that lies North of Buck Creek containing Eighty acres more or less all in Section fifteen Township Twenty Range three West and the West half of the South East quarter Section fourteen Township Twenty Range three West containing in all about three hundred and thirty acres more or less to have and to hold all and singular as to right Claims demands & Equities hereby Released as mentioned or intended so to be unto the said Lyman & Davis their heirs and assigns forever so that the said Nedham Lee his wife (nor his heirs nor any other person or persons Whomsoever claiming or to Claim by from or under them or either of them.
