 County Ala of the first part
 and George W Woolly of the same
 County and State of the second
 part. Witnesseth that the said Geo
 ge W Woolly party of the second
 part is now justly indebted to the
 said parties of the first part by
 open account in the sum for
 five ³/₄ good all are for supplies to ena
 ble the said party of the first part
 to make a crop for the present
 year & further that the said parties
 of the first part agree to contin
 ue to furnish said party of the
 second part with same goods
 as above stated in amount
 not to exceed in all one hundred
 Dollars the same to be due and pay
 able on or before the 25 day of Decem
 ber next. And whereas the said party
 of the second part is anxious &
 desirous to secure the ~~payment~~
 said parties of the first part in
 the payment of the open account
 to him as above stated at the time
 said account falls due. Therefore
 witnesseth that the said parties of the
 second part in consideration of the
 promises as well as for the further
 consideration of the sum of one dol
 lar to him in hand paid by the
 said parties of the first part at
 and before the sealing & delivery of

these presents the Receipt (whereof
 is hereby acknowledged have granted
 bargained sold and by these presents
 do grant bargain sell and convey
 unto the said parties of the first
 part all of my entire Crop of
 Every Kind grown by the said
 party of the second part the
 present year To have and to hold
 to the said parties of the first part
 their heirs and assigns forever. Now
 the Condition of the above and fore
 going obligation is such that if the
 said party of the second part
 shall well and truly pay or
 cause to be paid the full amount
 of the open account alluded to
 above on the day the same
 falls due then this obligation
 to be void else to remain in
 full force and effect. And the
 said parties of the first part
 are hereby authorized and empow
 ered to take possession of the afore
 mentioned Crop and sell the same
 to the highest bidder for cash after
 giving public notice of the same
 by written advertisement for ten days
 before sale and out of the money
 arising from said sale to pay off

Said open account entire and cost
and expenses of this instrument and the
balance if any to pay over to the said
party of the second part or his legal
Representative
