

P The State of Alabama, This indenture made and
 Shilly County, Entered into this the first
 day of June 1868 between Samuel Lewis
 debtor of the first part and A M & S F Elliott
 Creditors of the second part witnesseth: that
 whereas the said part of the first part is justly
 indebted to the said part of the second part
 in the sum of forty dollars due by a
 promissory note made by Lewis on the first
 day of June 1868 and payable on or before
 the first day of October 1868 and the said
 party of the first part being desirous
 to secure the payment of said indebted
 ness for and in consideration thereof and
 for the further consideration of the sum
 of one dollar to the party of the first part
 in hand paid by the parties of the second
 part the receipt whereof is hereby acknow-
 ledged the said party of the first part has
 sold and hereby sells and conveys to
 the said part of the 2d part the following
 described property to wit: all of my grow-
 ing crop of Corn and Cotton seeds &
 potatoes that I may raise or cause to
 be raised on my plantation the
 present year. To have and to hold in trust
 as follows: It is hereby agreed that the said
 party of the first part is to have and
 retain possession of said property until
 the first day of October 1868 and if the said
 party of the first part shall fully pay
 to the said part of the second part
 said debt with interest thereon and
 the reasonable expenses hereof by the
 said first day of October 1868 then
 this indenture to be null and void

but upon default of such payment then
the said part of the second part is hereby
authorized to take in to possession and
sell said property to the highest bidder
for cash after giving ten days notice
of the time and place of sale by
advertisement posted at three pub-
lic places and out of the proceeds of
such sale return the said sum
of forty dollars with the interest there-
on and the reasonable cost here-
of and the balance if any
pay over to the said part of the
first part,
