 order, to do the blacksmithing for the farm and
 to do the gining and thrashing and to take good
 care of all the farming tools placed in his
 hands, and to return them in good order
 and to work the mules in moderation and see
 that they are not abused he also agrees
 to find himself and all the hands he
 may employ and to pay his and their

Texas Doctor Bill & And the said first party
 agrees to give him one third of all the
 Corn Cotton fodder and Small grain made
 Raised and gathered by him and one half
 of all the Potatoes and Sorghum Raised
 and one third of all that is made by
 grinding and threshing out side of his own
 Crop which is to be gathered Threshed for
 of charge and also to furnish him a
 house to live in, and he the second
 party agrees that whatever amount he
 is still owing for advances made to him
 last year or any advances that may be made
 to him this year shall first be paid out
 of this crop before any other debt and
 he agrees to work under the supervision
 and direction of Mr B & Samuel dur
 ing the year, in testimony whereof witness
 our hands and seals the day and year above
 written.
