 the third part Witnesseth that whereas the said George
 Vaser during his Coverture with the said Caroline Vaser
 his wife as afore said has received the sum of one thousand
 Dollars in gold at divers times of the separate estate of the
 said Caroline Vaser, as follows to wit: in the year 1854
 five hundred Dollars in gold and in the year 1866 five
 hundred Dollars in gold And whereas the said George
 Vaser has never accounted with the said Caroline
 Vaser for the said sums of money received for her
 as afore said or the interest there on and has
 used and expended the same. And whereas he
 did use a certain portion of the said money
 of the said Caroline Vaser in the payment of
 the lands here in after described. Now in Con-
 sideration of the premises and also for the
 further consideration of the sum of ten
 Dollars in hand paid to the said

George Vasser by the said Amos M. Elliott the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said George Vasser has this day sold and conveyed in consideration of the premises done hereby bargain sell and convey to said Amos M. Elliott the following described lands lying and being in Shelby County and State of Alabama to wit; the North East quarter of the North West quarter and the South East quarter of the North West quarter and the North West quarter of the South West quarter and the East half of the South West quarter all in Section 21 of Township 21 of Range one West. Also two Cows and Yearlings. One horse and buggy. One one-horse wagon and 23 head of hogs. To have and to hold ^{together with} all and singular the tenements the tenements & ~~the~~ an said land in trust as follows to the said and separate use behoof and benefit of the said Caroline Vasser And it is agreed by the parties to these presents that the said Caroline Vasser is to have and enjoy possession and Control of said property here in conveyed to her sole and separate use and behoof free from the Control and Management of the said George Vasser with full power to use dispose and enjoy said property to her own separate use during her natural life & and to dispose of the same by Will or deed at any time.
