 Shelby County. & into on the 6th day of June 1868
 between J. M. Dinslow & Son of the first part & John R. Webb
 of the second part both of the County & State aforesaid).
 Witnesseth that the said J. M. Dinslow & Son of the first part
 have furnished formerly supplies to the amount of fifty
 thousand dollars or more in open account for the year
 1868 & agrees to furnish for or wish such supplies as he
 may have to the amount in all of one hundred
 dollars to the said John R. Webb of the second part
 & whereas the said party of the second part is anxious
 & desirous to receive the payment of the said account
 above alluded to on or before the first day of Nov-
 -ember next therefore Witnesseth that the said party
 of the second part in consideration of the premises
 as well as the further sum of one dollar & three in
 hand paid by the said party of the first part at &
 upon the sealing & delivery of these presents the

except thereof to hereby acknowledged have granted
 conveyed and sold by these presents unto the said trust of the first
 part all of my present growing crop of every kind
 & description to have & to hold unto the said trust of
 the first part their heirs & assigns forever.
 Now the Consideration of the above foregoing obligation
 is such that if the said trust of the second part
 shall will & lawfully pay or Cause to be paid the
 aforementioned account at the time the same
 falls due then this obligation to be void else to be
 but if the said trust of the second part shall
 to pay or Cause to be paid the said account
 at its maturity then the said trust of the first part
 is hereby authorized & empowered to take possession
 of the crop before mentioned & sell the same to
 the highest bidder for cash after giving two days
 notice of the time & place by written advertisement
 -ent before said sale & out of the funds arising
 from the sale of said crop to pay of the afore-
 mentioned account with Costs & expenses of the
 instrument & the balance if any to pay over to the
 said trust of the second part or any one legally
 representing him in testimony whereof the
 said trusts of the first & second parts have
 hereunto set their hands & seals on the day before
 mentioned.
