 said parties of the first part for and in consideration
 of the sum of the sum of one hundred dollars to them
 in hand paid by said party of the second part the
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have
 sold and hereby sell convey unto the said sec-
 -ond party the following described land lying in Shilley
 County State of Alabama to wit the N W 1/4 of the NW 1/4 section 23 in
 Township 19 R 1 West containing seventy (70) acres also the S E 1/4 of the NW 1/4 and a part of the N E 1/4 of the NW 1/4 and
 the South 1/2 of said 1/4 divided by designated line as follows
 Commence at the NW corner of a large white oak tree
 running East to the creek to another large white oak tree
 thence East to a large gum tree thence the line suppose
 be between Watsons & Nix and also containing sixty acres
 more or less all in Township 18 Sec 23 Range 1 East
 To have and to hold to said second party his heirs & assigns
 forever the above described land and premises and
 the said parties of the first part hereby covenant with
 with the party of the second part that they lawfully se-
 -ized and have good right to sell and convey said
 land and hereby bind ourselves our heirs and
 legal representatives forever to warrant and defend
 the title to said land and premises to the said party
 of the second part his heirs assigns and legal rep-
 -resentatives against the claims of and every person in
 law and equity and against the government of the United
