 bearing interest from date due the first of December
 1868 Now the said Charles H. Smart being
 and desirous to secure to the said M. Harper by
 giving him a lien on the following property to wit
 an the company Corp of Cotton raised for the year 1868
 Now if the above named Charles H. Smart fails to
 discharge the above named debt in or by the 1st day
 of December 1868 Then the said M. Harper shall have
 full power to take possession of said Corp and dis-
 - pose of it at public auction to the highest bidder
 for cash by giving two days notice of time and
 place in writing whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand and seal this day and year above written
