 the money here to fore paid said parties of
 the first part and because of a Verbal
 Mistake in an original deed. We Relinquish
 to J M Wilson of the second part all right and
 title to any and all lands here to fore owned by
 us in Section thirty (30) Township 21 and
 Range One (1) East, in Shelby County Alabama and
 this is our quit claim deed to said lands
 and is given to perfect said Wilson's title to the
