 sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell
 and convey unto the E. G. Walker the following

 vised and amended by Capt W. P. Schultz and adopted
 the intendant and Commissioners of said town the
 said lot fronting Valley Street feet and
 running back to main street extending the same
 number of feet along the said main street.
 the house and lot being the same formerly
 owned Edward King conveyed to Henry Sawyer
 and afterwards lived upon said and conveyed by

 and quietly have hold use occupy and enjoy the
