

The State of Alabama Shelling County.
 This indenture made and entered into the twenty eighth
 day of July, one thousand eight hundred and eighty eight
 between Mathew Haapio of the first part and A. J. H. Aronson
 of the second part both of the County and State aforesaid
 Witnesseth that whereas the said A. J. H. Aronson is indebted
 to the said M. Haapio in the sum of eleven dollars
 and thirty seven cents due the first day of December
 1848 bearing interest from date over the said A. J. H.
 Aronson being willing and desirous to secure to the
 said M. Haapio by giving him a lien on the follow-
 ing property to wit and his portion of the growing Cotton
 and Corn Crop raised for the year 1848

Now of the above named J. H. Crockett fails
 to discharge the above named debt as by the
 first day of December 1846: Then the said M. B. Cooper
 shall have full power to take possession of said
 Corp and dispose of it at public auction to the highest
 bidder for Cash by giving ten days notice of time
 and place in Wilmington Delaware I have hereunto set
 my hand and seal the day and year above written
