 dollars to them in hand paid by the said
 parties of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged have this day bargained and sold
 and by these presents do grant Bargain sell and convey
 to said parties of the second part their heirs assigns &
 all that certain tract or parcel of land situated in the
 County of Shelby and State of Alabama designated
 by this witness as follows viz The North half of the South
 west forth of Section Thirteen Township 21 Range four
 West containing in all Eighty acres to have and to
 hold the said tract of land & tenement to the said
 parties of the second part and to their heirs and assigns
 forever. And the said parties of the first part
 covenant with said parties of the second part that they
 are lawfully seized of said lands in fee simple have
 a good right to sell and convey the same and that
 they will forever warrant and defend the title thereto in
 inferior simple to said parties of the second part their
 heirs and assigns - In testimony whereof the said parties
