and sold, and do now by these presents, grant  
bargain, sell, Convey & Confirm unto the Said  
Shelby County" as such body Corporate the following  
descriptive tracts & parcels of lands to wit: The South  
East Quarter of the South East Quarter & the West half of the  
South East Quarter of Section Twenty two, of Township  
Twenty one, of Range one west (Excepting one and a half acres  
off of Said half quarter previously Conveyed to one  
H.S. Selous) and the North half of the North East Quarter  
of Section 27, Township 21, R. 1, West. Also two acres in a  
Square with North East corner of the South east quarter  
of the North East Quarter of Section Twenty Seven, in  
Township Twenty one of Range one West. And all  
that part of the South East Quarter of the North East  
Quarter of Section Twenty Seven in Township Twenty one  
of Range one West which lies North of the right of way of  
the Selma Rome & Dalton Rail Road Company all situated  
in Said County & Known as the Johnstons Trail, West or  
North West of & near Colindale Containing 204 1/2 acre  
more or less, To have and to hold Said tract & parcel  
of land unto the Said "Shelby County" body Corporate  
as aforesaid and Assign forever and I the Said  
Thomas Johnstons for myself my heirs, Executors & Administrators  
in Consideration of the premises do now by these
