

The State of Alabama } Third Indenture Made and  
 Shelby County } Entered into this 9 day of April  
 1870 between John Humbley & Co. Debtors of the first part  
 and Desmond Wilson Creditor of the 2nd part Witnesseth:  
 P That whereas the said party of the first part is jointly  
 indebted to the party of the 2nd part in the sum of  
 Fifty Dollars due by 1st part for 1870 for supplies and  
 payable on or before the 1st day of Nov 1870 and the  
 said party of 1st part being desirous to secure the  
 payment of said indebtedness; for and in consid-  
 eration thereof, and for the further consideration  
 of the sum of one dollar to the said party of the  
 1st part is here paid by the said party of the 2nd part  
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said



party of the 1<sup>st</sup> part have seen and hereby sell  
 convey to the said party of the 2<sup>nd</sup> part, the  
 following described property to wit: All the  
 Crop and Cotton to be Raised by me on  
 Wm. Payers land in the year 1870. Also  
 Cow & Calf the Cow Red to have and to hold in  
 trust as follows: It is hereby agreed that the  
 said party of the 1<sup>st</sup> part is to have and retain  
 possession of the said property until the 1<sup>st</sup>  
 day of Nov 1870 and if the said party of the 1<sup>st</sup> part  
 shall fully pay to the said party of the 2<sup>nd</sup> part said  
 debt with interest thereon and reasonable Expenses  
 hereof by said 1<sup>st</sup> day of Nov 1870 then this  
 indenture is to be removed. But upon  
 default of such payment the said party of the  
 second part is hereby authorized to let the said  
 possession and sell said property to the highest  
 bidder for cash after giving ten days notice  
 of the time and place of said sale by publica-  
 tion in a newspaper or on posted in the  
 County, or by posting at three public places and  
 out of the proceeds of said sale retain the sum  
 of Fifty Dollars and interest thereon and the  
 reasonable Costs hereof, and the balance if any  
 pay to the said party of the first part,  
 (Revenue Stamp fifty Cents) John P. Bradley Seal
