Shelby County, and Entered into the
third day of January One Thousand Eight Hun-
dred and Sixty Six between Harum Butler
of the first part, and the Shelby Lumber Company
composed of J. M. Lapsley, A. T. Gundersen, L. J. Hale,
R. C. Adams and J. R. O'Kernan of the second
part Witnesseth that the said party of the first
part have this day bargained and sold, and
by these presents do bargain, sell alien and
convey unto the said parties of the second
part all his right title and interest unto
the following described lands to wit. The
North East fourth of the South West fourth. Containing
 $39\frac{4}{100}$ acres and the South East fourth of the South
West fourth of Section 17 Containing $39\frac{4}{100}$ acres,
and the North East fourth of the North East fourth
of fractional Section 20. Containing $39\frac{8}{100}$ acres
and the West half of the North East fourth Containing
80 acres and the South East fourth of fractional
Section 21 Containing $91\frac{5}{100}$ acres the above des-
cribed land being in Township 22. Range 2
West, and also the North West fourth of the North West
fourth of Section 10 and Containing about 40 acres
and the South East fourth of the North East fourth
Containing about 40 acres, and the North East
fourth of the North East fourth Containing $40\frac{0}{100}$
acres and the North West fourth of the North East

fourth of Section (2) Two Containing 40 Acres
in Township (34) twenty four Range (18) Thirtieth East
in the Precinct of Land district in Shelby County
there being in all about four hundred and
fifty acres. for and in Consideration of the Sum
of Two thousand Seven hundred and Nine dollars
to the said Herman Butler in hand paid
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and
the said party of the first part doth for them-
selves their heirs Executors Administrators and
assigns warrant and defend. All the right title
and interest of said land unto the parties of
the second part. Their heirs Executors Administrators
and assigns together with all that belongs unto
said premises. against all persons or persons
having legal Claims against said lands.
