 Shelby County, Whereas A. B. Brown has this
 day advanced to the undersigned certain supplies
 farming implements provisions goods, wares
 and merchandise to the amount of One
 Hundred fifty Dollars agree to further advance
 to the undersigned from time to time
 during the current year supplies goods
 wares & merchandise to the amount of one
 Hundred fifty Dollars and whereas the
 said advances are obtained by the undersigned
 of the said A. B. Brown to enable him to make

A Crop the ensuing year and the same
 was obtained by the undersigned when the
 Agreement and in Consideration of this
 instrument and in good faith for the pur-
 pose of Making a Crop and that without such
 advances it would not be in the power of
 the undersigned to procure the necessary
 provisions Labor Stock and Supplies to
 make a Crop the present year. Now in con-
 sideration of the premises & the undersigned
 James Whitfield do hereby grant bargain and
 sell to the said A. R. Brown (3) Three Bales
 of good ordinary or low middling Cotton
 averaging five Hundred pounds to the
 Bale Seemingly packed and in good
 marketable Condition the same to be
 the first picked on my premises at the then
 Market price of such Cotton in the town
 of Montevalle and the said James Whitfield
 obliges himself to deliver the said
 Cotton to the said A. R. Brown on the 1st day
 of Nov 1870 in the town of Montevalle and
 the latter to secure the said A. R. Brown in
 the payment of the full value of said Cotton
 at the time stipulated for its delivery as above
 stated & the undersigned James M. Whitfield in
 Consideration of said advances do sell convey
 and do hereby grant bargain and sell to the
 said A. R. Brown the following personal property
 to wit: All the growing Crop of Corn and Cotton
 the mules horses and farming utensils of the
 said J. M. Whitfield now on his premises -
