 has this day advanced to the undersigned
 certain supplies farming implement provisions
 goods, wares and merchandise to the amount
 of One Hundred dollars agrees to further ad-
 vance to the undersigned from time to time
 during the current year. Supplies, goods, wares

& merchandise to the amount of one
 thousand dollars. And whereas the said
 advances are obtained by the undersigned
 of the said A. B. Brown to enable him to make
 a crop the ensuing year and the same was
 obtained by the undersigned when the government
 acts in consideration of this instrument
 and in good faith for the purpose of making
 a crop and that without such advances it
 would not be in the power of the under-
 signed to procure the necessary provisions
 labor stock and supplies to make a crop
 the present year in consideration of the promise
 of the undersigned James Ellison do hereby
 grant bargain sell to the said A. B. Brown
 One bale of good ordinary or low middling
 Cotton averaging five hundred pounds
 to the bale securely packed and in good
 marketable condition the same to be
 the first picked on my premises at the then
 market price of such Cotton in the Town
 of Montevalle and the said James Ellison
 obliges himself to deliver the said Cotton
 to the said A. B. Brown on the 1st day of Nov
 1870 in the town of Montevalle. And the better
 to secure the said A. B. Brown in the pay-
 ment of the full value of said Cotton at the
 time stipulated for its delivery as above stated
 of the undersigned James Ellison in con-
 sideration of said advances do sell and
 convey and do hereby grant bargain and
 sell to the said A. B. Brown the following per-
 sonal property to wit: All the growing crop of corn
 & Cotton the mules, horses and farming utensils
 of the said James Ellison. Now on his premises
