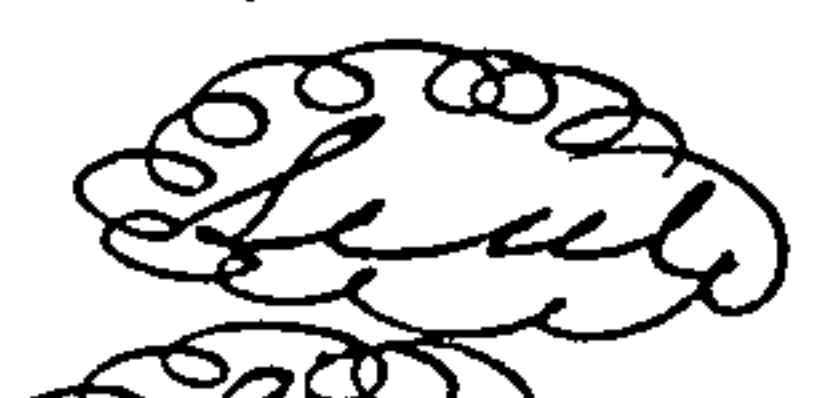

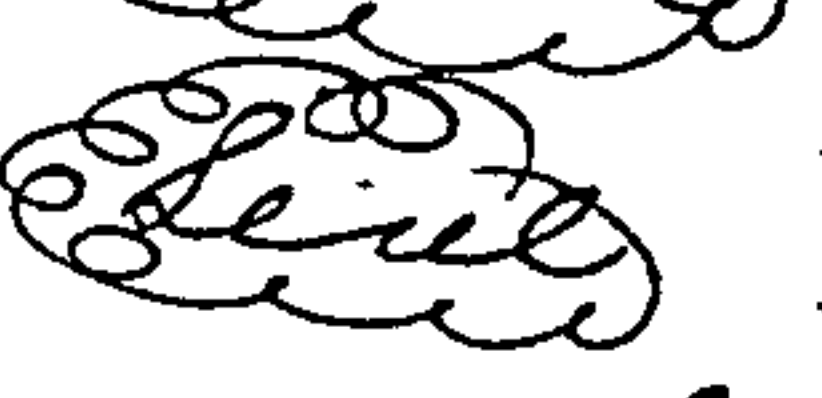
The State of Alabama; This Indenture, made
Shelby County 3 on the 30th day of April
1870 between A. J. Britton of the one part and
Andrew R. Brown of the other part Witnesseth,
Whereas the said Andrew R. Brown has sum-

undertaken and does truly agree to advance to the said A. J. Britton the necessary provisions farming tools and implements & money to purchase the same to the amount of seventy five dollars for Curb plough horse or mule worked on the plantation of said A. J. Britton to enable said A. J. Britton to make a crop and whenever the said advances are obtained by the said A. J. Britton bonafide for the purpose of making a crop during the current year and without such advances it would not be in the power of the said A. J. Britton to procure the necessary provisions and farming implements to make a crop Now therefore it is agreed and understood by and between the parties hereto that the said advance so made or the amount thereof shall be a lien on all the Crops Cotton Corn which the said A. J. Britton shall raise or grow during the said current year and all advances to be paid for on the 1st day of November next in Cotton at the market value of said Cotton - In testimony whereof the said parties have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year above written.
