 Entered into this 14 day of June 1870 between
 William Ryland debtor of the first part, and
 several persons of the 2nd part witnesses: That
 whereas the said party of the first part is partly
 indebted to the party of the 2nd part in the
 sum of One Hundred Dollars due by A. P. Moore
 in 1870 for his place and payable on or before the 1st
 day of Nov 1870 and the said party of 1st part being
 desirous to secure the payment of said in-
 debted sum; for and in consideration thereof
 and for the further consideration of the sum
 of one dollar to the said party of the 1st part

in hand paid by the said party of the 2nd part receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said party of the 1st part has sold and hereby Sells and Conveys to the said party of the 2nd part the following described property To-wit: All the Crop Corn & Cotton to be raised by and on any place or land when to be known and to hold in trust, as follows: It is hereby agreed that the said party of the 1st part is to have and retain possession of the said property until the 1st day of Nov 1870 and if the said party of the 1st part shall fully pay to the said party of the 2nd part said debt with interest thereon and reasonable Expenses hereof by said 1 day of Nov 1870 and if the said party of the 1st part shall fully pay to the said party of the 2nd part said debt with interest thereon and reasonable Expenses hereof by said 1 day of Nov 1870 then this induction is to be null and void But upon default of such payment the said party of the 2nd part is hereby authorized to take into possession and sell said property to the highest bidder for Cash, after giving Ten days notice of the time and place of said Sale by publication in a newspaper once published in the County, or by posting at three public places, and out of the proceeds of said Sale retain the sum of one hundred Dollars and interest thereon and its reasonable Costs hereof, and the balance if any pay to the said party of the 1st part, (Reverse thirty five Cents) *Wm Rylund Seal*
