 Entered into this 10th day of June 1870 between
 While Holcombback debtor of the first part and
 H. R. Symmes Creditor of the 2nd part witnesseth
 That whereas the said party of the first part
 is justly indebted to the party of the 2nd part
 in the sum of Fifty Dollars due by note
 and payable on or before the 1st day of November
 1870 and the said party of 1st part being desirous
 to secure the payment of said indebtedness for
 and in Consideration thereof and
 for the further Consideration of the sum
 of one dollar to the said party of the 1st part
 in hand paid by the said party of the 2nd part
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said
 party of the 1st part has sold and hereby sells and
 conveys to the said party of the 2nd part the
 following described property to wit: So much
 of my Crop of Cotton now planted and growing as

will make Two Thousand ~~four~~ hundred in the said
 said Crop of Cotton growing on my farm in
 Shelby Co. Ala and to be gathered & packed by the
 said Abiel Holcombback to have and to hold
 in trust as follows: It is hereby agreed that the
 said party of the 1st part is to have and retain
 possession of the said property until the 1st day
 of November 1870 and if the said party of the 1st
 part shall fully pay to the said party of the 2nd
 part said debt with interest thereon and
 reasonable Expenses hereof. by said first day
 of November 1870 then this indenture is to be
 null & void. But upon default of such payment
 the said party of the second part is hereby author-
 ized to take into possession and sell said
 property to the highest bidder for cash after
 giving fifteen days notice of the time and
 place of said sale by posting at three public
 places, and out of the proceeds of said sale
 return the sum of Fifty Dollars and interest
 thereon and the reasonable Costs hereof and
 the balance, if any pay to the said party of the
