The State and County, aforesaid of the one part
and John T. Morgan of the second part witnesseth

That for and in consideration of the sum
of Two Thousand Dollars to them seemed to be
paid by the said Morgan the said parties
of the first part hereby Allen Cuffoff and company
and former quit claim unto the said John
T. Morgan and his heirs and assigns in
fee simple forever the following lands
in Shelby County, with all and singular the
right title claim and interest which either of said
parties has or holds to said lands, described
as follows viz: the north East (NE) quarter and
the north East quarter of the South East quarter
of Section Eighteen and the north West quarter of
the north West quarter of Section Seventeen
in Township Twenty two of Range One. To
have and to hold said lands with all and
singular the tenements and appurtenances
unto the said parties of the second part and his
heirs & assigns in fee simple forever

The parties of the first part hereby expressly declare
that they do not warrant the title to said
lands in any way.
